





## "You're going to Bonaire?? Where's that?"

When I tell people that I am going to Bonaire, that is usually the first question I hear. My answer is, "It's a little island just north of the Venezuelan coast, near Aruba and Curacao."

This description only scratches the surface of all that is Bonaire. Because of its location just 800 miles north of the equator, Bonaire has a dry and mild climate - temperatures remain between 77-90 degrees throughout the year. Bonaire has a total area of 113 square miles, just 17 miles from north to south, and between 3 to 7 miles wide, much of it flat, volcanic rocks covered in limestone.

A variety of cultures have called the island of Bonaire home. There is evidence of Arkaiko and Caquetios Indians dating back to 2500 BC on the island. The Spanish explorers claimed Bonaire for Spain in 1499, later transferring ownership to the Dutch. Over 80% of the current 20,000 residents of Bonaire are Dutch nationals. The official language is Dutch, with the locals speaking Papiamento (a mix of Dutch, Spanish, French, English and Portuguese). English is also widely spoken on the island.

















Each month, over 15,000 visitors arrive in Bonaire by air or on a cruise ship stopover. Both cruises and the Flamingo Airport arrivals land in the capital city of Kralendijk. From there, all sorts of adventures are possible!

Bonaire is known in the scuba diving community as the "Shore Diving Capital of the World." This is because over 60 dive sites around the island are clearly marked by yellow painted stones. There are many guide books and YouTube videos describing access to the sites by road, great maps of the reef to explore and the best way to enter and exit the waters. Truck and scuba tank rental is widely available in Bonaire. Divers can grab their gear, put their scuba tanks in the back of their truck and hit the water. Many

resorts offer boat diving as well, enabling divers to reach the reefs without all the hard work of shore diving, with a guide to lead the way.



The reefs of Bonaire are healthy and thriving due to the management of STINAPA (Stichting Nationale Parken Bonaire). STINAPA was founded in 1962 and manages Bonaire's nature parks on behalf of the Bonairian government. STINAPA manages the Bonaire National Marine Park, founded in 1979 which covers all the waters surrounding Bonaire and Klein Bonaire, from the high-tide mark to 60 meters (200 feet) of depth, and Washington Slagbaai National Park, the land-based park in the north.







STINAPA collects an entry fee from all divers, snorkelers, and park visitors. They also require all divers to participate in an orientation and a checkout dive before air tank rental. This orientation covers the rules of the park, as well as reminders of safe diving practices to protect the coral and animals of the marine park. Snorkelers can also easily enjoy the reefs, as many of the reefs begin within feet of the shoreline.

Bonaire has plenty of activities and adventure above the waterline as well. Visitors can rent trucks, motorcycles, or even golf carts to explore the island. The capital city of Kralendijk has a historical walking tour, as well as dining and shopping within easy reach. Once you leave Kralendijk, head south to visit the Salt Works, where sea salt is harvested and shipped around the world. It's also worth stopping at some of the five lighthouses and slave huts around the island to appreciate the history and views.

Visitors can head to the east side of the island to Lac Bay. More adventurous divers can head out of the bay to dive the windward side of the island, home to the Sea Turtle Conservation Bonaire, expect to see lots of sea turtles on every dive. Windsurfers and kite boarders will enjoy the continuous winds and waves on Lac Bay. You can also sit back on the beach, relax and soak up the sun while eating lunch at one of several restaurants. There are even two ranches on Bonaire that offer horseback riding tours of the island, sometimes allowing a quick swim on horseback in the bay.

For an all-day excursion, visit Washington Slagbaai National Park. The park sits on the northern 17% of the island. Once you have rented your truck (as many rental cars are forbidden to be taken into the park), travel through the city of Rincón to the park entrance. Make sure you have brought plenty of water and snacks, as there is no place to purchase them once inside the park. Park guides will provide a map of hiking trails and scenic vistas to enjoy along the way. Much of the road is unpaved, and there is sometimes two-way traffic on a narrow road. Along the route you may encounter flamingoes, iguanas, Karakara, and many blue whiptail lizards. The terrain is rough and wild with volcanic upwellings, cacti, rocky shorelines and blowholes. Several beaches along the way provide a place to rest and enjoy the views, or entry to the water to cool off with your snorkeling gear.

Bonaire is definitely one of the Caribbean's best kept secrets for beauty and adventure! AW



# Snow Day








#### THERE IS NO CERTAINTY; THERE IS ONLY ADVENTURE

#### MOUNTAIN MISCHIEF

With almost no traction on pavement, we quickly found the gravel roads to be nearly as bad. Within the first 15 minutes, we'd already each crashed more than once; the kind of crashes which don't necessarily hurt, but happen so quickly that you're on the ground and wondering what happened without having any real idea why other than the obvious culprit of ice lurking underneath the snow.

We quickly aborted our planned riding route, and found ourselves chasing each other through trails, jumping over logs (Joel won), testing our wheelie skills (we all lost), and acting like kids riding dirt bikes for the first time. It was a blast.

#### **CALLING AN AUDIBLE**

The games, single track trails, and exploratory bushwhacking kept us entertained, and something slightly warmer than freezing, for a few hours. Several theatrical crashes proved both entertaining and humorous, though ultimately, the lure of lunch and the opportunity to thaw our frozen bodies led us back to the house, where we discussed alternative adventures with more secure footing for the afternoon.



#### ALTERNATIVE EXPLORATIONS

As a precautionary back-up, we'd packed snowshoes should the weather thwart our intentions to ride. We figured they would cover our bases and allow adventure of some variety

regardless of weather. After a quick lunch, we drove south of Sisters as far as the forest service road was plowed of snow. Twenty minutes later we set out on snowshoe for Three Creek Lakes, at the NE foot of Broken Top, an extinct, glacially eroded volcano sitting at 9,171 feet.

#### SOLITUDE

Being alone in the woods on snowshoes was almost as much fun as an escape on bike. Surrounded by a blanket of falling snow and an absolute silence aside from our own breathing, we felt far removed from any thoughts or distractions of our daily lives. Solitude often rewards one with a sense of freedom, heightened by the effort it often takes to reach your destination.





#### **EYES OPEN**

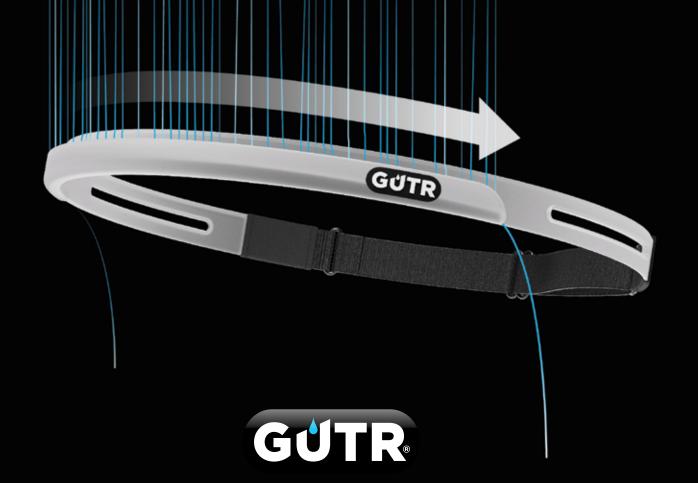

# Purpose-Driven Defense Optics

As a mechanism for equality between predator and victim and the rightful preservation of one's life, firearm ownership should be considered. While owning, keeping and carrying firearms comes with distinct responsibilities, most lawful citizens are willing to accept these responsibilities. However, government entities continue to mine for stricter gun control laws, including



bans and confiscations. Unfortunately, such strategies disarm the law abiding public while leaving predators armed and unphased. Moreover, considering today's dated yet continuing pandemic mandates, unemployment and our global economic climate, some people are primed to take more desperate measures. This unsettled dynamic makes it more important than ever to plan and equip for your personal defense measures, including knowing your laws, owning personal and home defense firearms, setting them up properly, and training for defensive situations.

#### In the home

Popular home defense firearms include handguns, semi-automatic rifles and shotguns. With respect to handguns, revolvers are popular, however more gun owners choose semi-automatic handguns with larger magazine capacities—revolvers typically hold 5-6 rounds. Currently, there are no magazine restrictions, leaving the option open for your defense weapon to hold as many rounds as necessary to neutralize a threat. For this reason, detachable-magazine semi-automatic rifles like AR-15s and PCC9s are also very popular. For simplicity's sake... and for the internationally recognized sounds of a pump action or semi-auto model chambering a shell that tends to turn criminals away, shotguns continue to enjoy immense popularity.

My personal preference at home and to keep distance while still taking productive more accurate shots is an AR-platform semi-automatic rifle. Both the AR-15 and my personal choice, the PCC9 - an AR style rifle chambered in 9mm, are excellent options for home defense at further distances such as across a large room or across the length of a house. A rifle system of some kind, coupled with an optic that delivers solid low light performance and rapid target engagement, is preferred.



At closer distance, including in smaller rooms, a handgun is better suited. Until my son grew up, I stationed a handgun in a biometric vault in his closet. In case of a home robbery, my first area of defense would be my son's bedroom. I did not want to be in a position of getting to my son's room without something to protect him. While he never had access to the handgun, I could access it in seconds. For rapid access in close quarters, I have always had a

9mm handgun in close proximity to our bed, as well as a rifle incase the opportunity to engage a threat can be had at a greater distance than them breaking through my bedroom door. I may also have a handgun or rifle conveniently hidden in an open area like our living room. In either case, sights or optics compatible with low-light shooting are important components.

For me, shotguns come in last for home defense. Not because they aren't great defense options, but because of the lackluster ammo capacity. Given a worst-case scenario of a violent home robbery with several actors, my greatest leverage rests in how I am able to react and how many rounds I can employ to stop the threats. If two robbers are armed with 9mm pistols with 15-round magazines, I want more than three shotgun shells to fight for my family's lives. Of course, beyond a numbers game, when bad things happen picking and committing to the right firearm for your home defense job is also subjective. Comfort, magazine capacity, ease of use and personal preferences all come into play.

#### On the go

Fortunately for some carrying handguns for personal defense is legal and it is hard to argue against the rationale of too much over too little. In the heat of a moment, nobody wants to be short on anything that keeps a citizen in the fight... and ultimately surviving the encounter. In a debate over magazine capacities I was once asked, "How many rounds do you really need?" My answer was simple, "as many rounds as it takes to stop the threat." Nobody can or should answer that question for you.

Looking at the dwindling percentages of residents who feel safe, who feel that criminal rehabilitation is working or who feel that police responses are adequate are all important factors when determining what is best when taking responsibility for your own security - again this is subjective. The only bad answer is to do nothing or wait for others,

including police officers, to protect you. After all, the old adage is true – the police are not there to protect you from crime, they are there to investigate a crime after it happens. When seconds count, you or another nearby citizen may be the first or only responder.



#### Choices, choices

Choosing the right optics for in home and personal defense can be daunting. There are as many optic choices as there are types and models of firearms and like firearms, most are often purpose driven. Using a hunting riflescope on a home defense rifle may not yield the results you hope for if things go bad. It is tough to focus on a bad guy at 3x magnification power when he is standing 15 feet away. For in home defense, as well as personal defense, your best option is always going to be true 1x magnification (none) or as close to 1x as possible. Longer outdoor shots may justify higher-powered magnification but we are not discussing those here except to say a 3x or 5x fold to side magnifier can also be a great solution in longer range environments. Mounted iron sights, including flip-up models can be important if an optic fails. Finally, the ability to co-witness an optic to a front site can be important.

Sightmark offers an array of premium performing, ultra-dependable red dot and reflex optics perfect for defense rifles and pistols of all shapes, sizes, purposes and forms of carry. 
