





We took a short lunch break during which I decided that once we hit the slopes again, I would practice my stopping until I reached perfection. I was nervous our first time down the real slope, since I didn't



After ski school my aunt and uncle came to ski with us and my uncle taught me how to stop by turning and pointing my skis up the mountain instead of pizzaing which helped a lot.

On day two, I skied with my cousins which meant it was time to hit some real runs. We headed up the mountain and skied down Home Run, which was a little harder than I expected. The stopping practice the day before came in handy and I successfully completed my first real run. Unfortunately, after wrestling with the inability to stop, I had two speeds - wildly out of control fast or overly cautiously slow. But with practice throughout the day I worked on building up speed and becoming more comfortable and in control of my skis.

We took a day off from skiing to swim in a hot spring crater and I learned how to ice skate – fun!

On day three, my cousins took me even higher up the mountain where we skied down Bonanza and then Home Run. One thing that added to my confidence was my cousin's opinions that Home Run was a difficult green, which made me feel better about my wipeouts. I took day three easier, and relaxed so I could enjoy the skiing rather

Coast XP80R

The rechargeable Coast XP80R is literally lightning in a bottle. The IP54 torch has 5 levels – low, medium, high, Turbo and MoonGlow making it useful for any situation. Turbo provides 15,000 lumens while the MoonGlow mode is a low-energy eco beam. The XP80R has POWERiQ which provides a real-time display that provides the user with the mode and the remaining run time in the battery on that mode. The light also features overheat protection that automatically decreases output if the circuitry reaches a threshold temperature and an adjustable slide beam focus which can go from spot to flood. Coast included a USB-C charging port for the rechargeable ZITHION-X ZX880 battery along with a separate USB-C port that provides power-out for charging other devices. The light can also run on 9 AA alkaline batteries and features a power lock to prevent accidental engagement and battery drainage. Backed by COAST's lifetime warranty, the rechargeable XP80R is a super powerful light that you will want in your tool box.







At the end of May of this year, I boarded a plane to Europe for the first time. Though I longed to wander European streets, taste new dishes and hear an abundance of foreign words, I mostly desired to prove to myself that I could navigate a new place, and that I could do so by myself.

This desire manifested itself in different ways during my two-month solo trip, but in Spain it presented itself in the 200-mile trek I did across the northwestern countryside. Trekking across Spain to reach Santiago de Compostela near the western coast has been a tradition for centuries. The first pilgrim, King Alfonso II, made his way from the cathedral in Oviedo to the cathedral in Santiago in 813. In doing so, he hoped to pay tribute to St. James, whose remains were held in the cathedral. Alfonso II's route to Santiago, later termed the "Camino Primitivo", became known as the original pilgrimage to Santiago. Today there are hundreds of different routes to Santiago beginning in various parts of Spain and dozens of other countries.




I first heard of the "Camino de Santiago" from a mentor who biked from Oviedo to Santiago a few years ago. The following year, one of my childhood friends trekked from France to Santiago with his girlfriend, sharing his feelings about the experience on social media. The moment I realized both people in my life had, for their own personal reasons, completed a lengthy trek across Spain to the same alluring city, I felt the itch to board a plane and begin the adventure myself.

On May 28, 2024, I stared at the overcast skies surrounding Oviedo's innate cathedral in the early morning, wondering what the thirteen days ahead of me had in store. I breathed in and out, and then took my first step.

Quickly, I became accustomed to the click-click of my trekking poles on the pavement. The first couple

miles involved winding through the streets of Oviedo, before ascending up into the green hillside that led to the Cantabrian mountains. The day was longer and more difficult than I expected. My initial excitement wavered at different points, particularly during the hot hours of early afternoon when every rock seemed to be digging into the soles of my shoes. Despite the company of new friends I encountered on the trail, my hips ached from carrying such a heavy pack, and I longed to have completed the day's mileage. Eventually, I arrived in the city of Grado after nearly seven hours of walking.









Each day of the Camino presented its unique challenges. Sometimes, the uphills felt never-ending, the hot trail stretching off into the distance seemingly forever. Other days, the downhills proved to be surprisingly treacherous. Steep descents slowed the speed of every traveler, all of us fearing for a turned ankle or injured knees. At some moments I walked in a big group with many pilgrims, chatting about the journey behind and ahead of us while we stopped for lunch. Other days I walked completely alone, left to contemplate why I had decided to fly to Spain in the first place. Sometimes the heat scorched my legs, and during other moments the misty rain dampened my mood. On day three the blister on my right foot left me in such excruciating pain that I limped my way to my shared room, and collapsed onto my bed into a silent eruption of tears. I didn't think I could continue, and began wondering if I should just give up. The late lunch I had with my friends afterwards felt even more overwhelming and disappointing. I couldn't understand as much Castilian Spanish as I anticipated, and with every word and joke I missed, I began to feel increasingly alone.


Despite the pain I was experiencing both physically and emotionally, I decided to take another step. And I did so every day for the next ten days.

In total, I walked over 200 miles before reaching Santiago de Compostela on June 9, 2024!















When I look back to my experience trekking on foot from one part of Spain to the other, I have a lot of gratitude in my heart. Certainly, I'm thankful to have wandered new streets and trails, to have tried delicious food and to have learned new phrases in Castilian. I also feel thankful to have completed an ambitious goal I set many months ago. More than anything else, however, I feel privileged to have met and befriended so many kind hearted, selfless, curious and adventurous people. I could not have completed the Camino without their support and friendship. When I think of my time in Spain, I don't focus on the days and hours I spent alone, but instead I dwell on the moments I shared with the fellow travelers walking with me. I'm already looking forward to my next Camino. AW






